A LETTER TO THE CFC FAMILY

Dear CFC Family,

With reference to the International Council letter of August 31, entitled "Preserving and Protecting Unity in the Body," we wish to inform you that:

1. A copy of the said letter was delivered to each of the brothers mentioned therein – Tony Meloto, Luis Oquinenena, Mazi Oquinenena, Mike Goco, Delfy Giraldez, Jun Dimarucot, Jojo Buncayo and Francis Balagtas.
2. Fifteen days after receipt of the letter, they have not replied, with the exception of Francis Balagtas. These brothers, who profess to be CFC, have not complied with one basic requirement for continued CFC membership – adherence to CFC culture and tradition, support for one CFC global direction flowing out of one CFC leadership, and submission to the defined lines of authority within the community, as embodied in our Vatican Statutes.

In view of the above, we now take the painful step of delisting the brothers mentioned above from the CFC membership roster. This is consistent with our Vatican Statutes, our pastoral guidelines, and our CFC way of life and culture, as we mentioned in the August 31 letter.

In the case of Francis Balagtas, who responded in a letter dated September 9, 2010, we have referred his case to the Sector Head of South B for evaluation of the points he raised. Final action on his case will be made by the IC.

Therefore, effective today, September 15, 2010, the brothers mentioned above, except Francis Balagtas, are no longer members of Couples for Christ.


